Minutes of the Meeting of Langsett Parish Council held at The Barn, Langsett on Wednesday 14th January 2026 at 7.00pm

25/26-090 Apologies for absence

25/26 -091 Declarations of interest

25/26 -092 Minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday 12th November 2025

25/26 -093 Matters arising from the previous minutes

25/26 -094 Tom Newman, The Steel Valley Project

Tom Newman, The Steel Valley Project (environmental charity) discussed current projects and suggested projects that they could help the parish council with. **Resolved:** the Parish Council would consider if previously proposed projects (e.g Children's trail, Pond picnic area etc) may be pursued with help gaining funding via the Steel Valley project and any funding donation to the Steel Valley project the parish council may be able to make.

25/26 - 101 Finance and Accounts

101.2 Bank reconciliation figures to 1st January 2026 received and noted

101.3 The discontinuation of Parish Council Defibrillator was discussed together with the cost implications of new purchase and supplies.

Resolved: order spare pads and a chargepak for current defibrillator but currently the back order is from October 2025. **Resolved:** Clerk to look at funding options for a new defibrillator.

101.4 Defibrillator Training event the Clerk had received approximately 10 people interested in attending. **Resolved:** Clerk to check training availability and any costs involved.

101.5 New website and e-mail – work is still ongoing. **Resolved:** pay the invoice of the current website provider for the current year and discontinue the contract when the new website is ready to launch. **Resolved:** request refund of Microsoft Office from supplier of new laptop.

101.6 Budget requirements in relation to preparation of budget and precept request were considered. **Resolved:** the draft Budget was discussed and accepted, and the Precept request for 2026-2027 was agreed to be increased by 3% to £4,180.

25/26 -102 Items to bring to the attention of BMBC Neighbourhood Services

Resolved: continue reporting lack of dog bin at the top of Brookhouse Lane.

The issue of gritting within the village area was discussed but as the road is not adopted, gritting would need to be organised privately by the residents.

25/26 -103 Footpaths and Public Rights of Way Issues

The condition of the roadway up to “North America” has eroded and emergency vehicles would not be able to access this area. **Resolved:** report to Yorkshire Water.
