22/23 - 080 Planning Applications re parking charges relating to Langsett Barn and Langsett Flouch car parks

It was noted that the application for Langsett Barn Car Park was brought before the Peak District National Park Authority Planning Board in October and that the application had been approved. National Highways had not raised any objections to the application which was noted 3 times at the Planning Board. It is anticipated that the application for Langsett Flouch car park would be resubmitted. It was resolved to contact National Highways to voice concerns that no objections had been raised, as it was felt National Highways position would be important if Langsett Flouch application is resubmitted.

22/23 - 084 Information regarding Silkstone Neighbourhood Development Plan and local planning questions

- (a) Large metal gates had been installed in the Langsett reservoir wall on Midhope Cliffe Lane. PDNPA had been contacted to ask if permission had been sought as the Parish Council had not received notification. The situation is being investigated by PDNPA.
- (b) A large wooden bin storage had been erected in Langsett Barn car park. As the Parish Council had not received notification, it was **resolved** to contact PDNPA for clarification.
- (c) BMBC Design of housing supplementary planning document consultation had been circulated but no comments raised.
- (d) Silkstone Neighbourhood Development Plan had been received but no comments made.

22/23 - 085 Items to bring to the attention of BMBC Neighbourhood Services

Resolved: raise issue to Yorkshire Water of increasing number of dog bags on the path from Midhope Cliffe Lane to the reservoir.

The mattress on A628 layby is still there and the amount of litter remains in the laybys on the A628. **Resolved**: report again to BMBC.

22/23 - 086 Flouch Roundabout

National Highways had been contacted to ask what the plan for the roundabout is, and if no plan, could the roundabout just be strimmed on a regular basis. To be advised.

22/23 - 087 Roads, Transport and Parking

As resolved, The Clerk has written to BMBC, Ward Councillors and Miriam Cates MP for support regarding request to implement traffic regulation orders on local highways and has requested National Highways to attend a parish council meeting to discuss proposals.

22/23 - 088 Footpaths and Public Rights of Way Issues

Issue with gate on Brookhouse Lane reported to BMBC but handle still missing . **Resolved**: awaiting BMBC but will contact again.

Gate from Midhope Cliffe lane is broken. **Resolved:** report to BMBC

Resolved: invite the new Yorkshire Water Ranger team to a Parish Council meeting discuss remit and partnership working.

22/23 - 089 Peak Park Forum meetings
