CAR PARK CHARGES LANGSETT BARN

The planning application submitted by Yorkshire Water to install ANPR cameras and payment meters was approved by the Peak District National Park Authority (PDNPA) in October 2022.

Yorkshire Water have stated that this is a trial period of 18 months from installation of charging equipment, to allow the impacts of parking charges on the surrounding roads, and our community, to be assessed.

Langsett Parish Council will continue to work with National Highways, Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council and Yorkshire Water to monitor the impact of the parking charges, and will continue to address any issues residents raise in this respect. The Parish Council contact details are below.

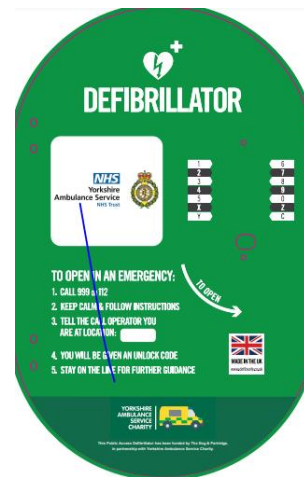
DOG & PARTRIDGE DEFIBRILLATOR
