### Super-Fast Broadband

We would like to thank Sandra, a local resident, for contacting Miriam Cates MP in regards to the ongoing slow broadband speeds experienced by Langsetts Residents. We had a very positive meeting with Miriam which led to a further meeting with the South Yorkshire superfast broadband lead. The good news is that Langsetts is included in the latest bid for funds in South Yorkshire with a very good chance of selection, although not guaranteed. We have included a copy of the questionnaire designed by Sandra. If you would like to complete this and return it by dropping it off at the Bank View Cafe. However, a key bit of information is whether you would be interested in taking up superfast broadband if it became available. We have in excess of 140 properties and businesses in Langsetts. Although the number of interested properties has no effect on the result of the bid it could affect the order of the roll out.

## THE KINGS CORONATION CELEBRATION EVENT

Thank you to all who attended the afternoon tea to celebrate the King's Coronation Celebration on the 7<sup>th</sup> May. A special thank you to all who donated delicious cakes, enjoyed by over 40 attendees including visitors who happened to be passing, popped in and joined in the celebrations! We hope they were impressed by the hospitality of Langsett Parish.

**MEETING WITH LOCAL POLICE** In July we asked South Yorkshire Police to meet with the Parish Council and residents to discuss local crime. 14 residents and 4 local Police officers (from Stannington and Penistone) discussed local crime issues, and to provide support and advice.

**SATURDAY 4<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER** The litter pick followed by refreshments earlier in the year was so popular, it was decided to hold another litter pick and "meet the Councillors" and "meet Yorkshire Water Rangers" event on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> November. Although the weather was not on our side for the litter pick, it gave residents and the Parish Council the opportunity to chat with the Yorkshire Water Rangers Team Leader and the Land and Property Portfolio Manager.

**GILBERT HILL** The Parish Council received proposals from BMBC to attempt to resolve the issues of parking on Gilbert Hill by introducing a one-way system. After discussions at Parish Council meetings and feedback from residents, the Parish Council rejected the initial proposals due to negative effects the proposals were envisaged to have for residents. New proposals awaited.

## PLANS FOR THE FUTURE

As well as continuing to deal with issues around parking issues, litter, and fly-tipping, the Parish Council are also hoping to work with Yorkshire Water to improve local areas i.e. around the pond, to improve areas of bilberry bushes, and hope to introduce a Nature Trail for children. We will let residents know when we have dates for volunteer work.

## LANGSETT BARN & LANGSETT FLOUCH CAR PARKS

The plans for the introduction of ANPR cameras and parking charging equipment have been given planning approval but we are still awaiting confirmation of the date Yorkshire Water will introduce payment charges. This is anticipated as sometime in 2024, following trials in other locations.
