# What's been happening?

## Parish Council Website

The website is updated with information regarding local news e.g. roadworks and wider news from Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council, Peak District National Park Authority and Yorkshire Water where it impacts on our parish.

## **Litter Bins**

The Parish Council have been working closely with Yorkshire Water regarding the issue of increased litter in Langsett Barn Car Park and are very pleased to report that new larger bins have now been installed.

Thank you to Yorkshire Water for the improved litter collection facilities, and for the increased number of collections, and to the Peak District National Park Rangers and Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council for removing the litter.

### DO YOU RECOGNISE THIS PLANT?



**Himalayan Balsam** has large, pink flowers shaped like a bonnet; these are followed by hanging, green seed pods, and is an invasive species.

There are clumps of Himalayan Balsam around the parish and you may have seen working parties in the area who have removed the vast majority of balsam from Yorkshire Water land in close proximity to Langsett. Many thanks to the Peak District National Park Ranger Team and their team of dedicated Peak District National Park volunteers.

#### Japanese Knotweed

Unfortunately, an area of Japanese Knotweed has been found locally and the Parish Council have taken **immediate** action to deal with the issue and specialists are dealing with its eradication from the area.

#### Safety Measures Brook House Lane

There are new signs at **Brook House Lane** prohibiting parking on the access to the moors. **Thanks to Yorkshire Water** for noting the concerns of the Parish Council regarding parking on the lane which was preventing access for emergency vehicles to the moors and installing the new signs.

## **Parking Issues**

There has been a significant increase in the number of visitors to the parish but unfortunately there has also been an increase in parking issues.

Langsett Parish Council are currently working with Highways England and Yorkshire Water, together with Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council to look at the issues faced in the parish and seek further measures to alleviate the current problems.
